Grattansbrook 1.1 Single Farm Origin is the 1st release from the 2015 Grattansbrook farm harvest of Taberna barley grown on a flat, fertile flood plain in Co. Kildare. Grattansbrook 1.1 is available exclusively in the UK and has been aged for over 3 years & 10 months in multiple cask types including first-fill ex-bourbon, virgin US & French oak.

NOTES OF MARZIPAN, WHITE GRAPES AND LEMON ZEST

Waterford's Grattansbrook 1.1 has a rich texture with a dry and oily finish. Notes of raisin, cocoa powder, marzipan, green tea, white grapes and brown sugar on the nose, accompanied by citrus zest, toffee, exotic spices and banana on the palate.



ENJOY NEAT

Best enjoyed neat or with a few drops of water to allow the cereal notes and viscous texture to open up. As this whisky is not chill-filtered, it has great depth of flavour and spreads across the palate with evolving complexity.

TERROIR-DRIVEN APPROACH

set up in 2015 with the purpose of producing whisky that focuses on barley and the impact different terroirs and growing conditions will have on the flavour of the whisky. Waterford's Single Farm Origin series is a range of limited-edition whiskies that explore Irish "teireoir" – using the barley from one farm at a time.

METICULOUS PRODUCTION TECHNIQUES

Long fermentation and slow double distillation creates an impactful flavour and the texture is maximized by no chill filtration or additional colouring.
