Waterford Gaia is the only certified organic Irish whisky and is made from organic Irish barley grown on six farms. It is a complex and viscous whisky with an amazing purity and precision. Gaia, the neopagan goddess of 'Mother Earth' is a fitting name.

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Waterford Gaia 2.1 is the first release from the second harvest of organic barley that Waterford distilled. It was fermented for 181 hours and aged for 4 years and 7 months. The whisky has a rich texture with notes of fig rolls, grapefruit, orange zest, cherry and liquorice with a long and complex finish.

TERROIR DRIVEN APPROACH

Waterford was setup up by Mark Reynier in 2015, with the vision of creating a whisky that was driven by the raw ingredient – the barley. Waterford focus on different types of barley, grown in different areas of Ireland with different micro climates and growing conditions, exploring how that affects the flavour of the whisky.

TOTAL TRANSPARENCY

Each bottle of Waterford includes a 'Teireoir' Code, which, when entered into their website, will reveal a host of unprecedented and engaging content. Explorers will be able to see maps of the farm, details of the harvest, the grower and distillation process. Each entry shows a mixture of information designed to delight the most curious whisky fan, as well as content to draw casual drinkers into the concept of real provenance.



BEST ENJOYED NEAT

Enjoy neat or with a few drops of water to allow the cereal notes and viscous texture to open up. As this whisky is not chill-filtered, it has great depth of flavour and evolving complexity.
