## THE FRENCH COGNAC WITH A BRITISH SOUL

Created in 1763, Hine is proudly one of the oldest houses in the region and is named after Thomas Hine of Dorset. Hine's philosophy of creating the highest quality Cognacs, respects the Maison's heritage and terroir. This is noted by the British Royal family who bestowed the Royal Warrant for Cognac to Hine in 1962; the only Cognac house to hold this honour.



## GRANDE & PETITE CHAMPAGNE

All of Hine's cognacs are produced from grapes grown in the Petite and Grande Champagne areas, two of the most prestigious growing regions in Cognac. As vineyard owners, Hine's expertise is ensuring that the original, delicate flavour from the grapes persists through the distilling, ageing and blending process.

The Hine house style is distinctly elegant and packed full of fruit and floral notes. The cognacs are loved by connoisseurs and novices alike, thanks to their velvety texture and long finish.

## HOMAGE TO THOMAS HINE

Created in 2007 to celebrate Thomas Hine's British roots, this XO Cognac is a blend of more than 20 Grande Champagne eaux-de-vie, including four aged in cellars in the UK.

## DELICATE, ELEGANT AND REFRESHING

Hine Homage reveals aromas of candied orange peel, buttered brioche and ripe pear. On the palate, stewed apples, hazelnuts, winter spices and toffee balance with layers of complexity and elegance.



## BEST ENJOYED NEAT

Hine Homage is best sipped neat to explore the complex and elegant flavours and the balance between dry nuttiness and fruitiness.

## EARLY LANDED

Hine Homage contains Cognacs from four single vintages of the 1980s that have been aged in more humid UK conditions. This means that the Cognac develops different flavours as it ages.
