Nikka Miyagikyo Single Malt is a complex, fruity and soft single malt whisky made at the Miyagikyo distillery near Sendai on Japan's main island of Honshu.

GRASSY NOTES, CANDIED CITRUS PEEL AND SPICES WITH A RICH SHERRY INFLUENCE

Made from unpeated and lightly peated barley which gives a complex and delicate whisky with notes of freshly cut grass, nuts, citrus peel and the merest wisp of smoke.

THE FATHER OF JAPANESE WHISKY

Nikka was founded in 1934 by Masataka Taketsuru, often referred to as "The Father of Japanese Whisky". Taketsuru travelled to Scotland in 1918 to learn the art of whisky-making.

MODERN AND INNOVATIVE DISTILLERY

Miyagikyo opened in 1969 after Taketsuru had been making whisky at Yoichi distillery for 35 years, built with modern equipment and designed to produce a fruity alternative to Yoichi's coastal flavours.



BEST ENJOYED NEAT OR ON THE ROCKS

Best enjoyed neat or on the rocks to experience the full complexity of the spirit. Bottled at 45%, it is smooth enough to not need water when sipping.
