A full-bodied and complex single malt whisky made in tropical Bangalore from 100% Indian barley. This whisky is bottled at 46% ABV with no colouring added and no chill filtration.

UNPEATED WITH NOTES OF CHOCOLATE ANDTROPICAL FRUITS

An unpeated whisky which is aged in American oak casks in the tropical heat. It has notes of honeysuckle, citrus, chocolate, malted milk, tropical fruits and baking spices.

MADE USING HERITAGE INDIAN BARLEY

Made from barley grown in the fertile foothills of the Himalayas - also known as the 'breadbasket of India'. This 6-row barley adds more flavour and texture compared to that grown in Europe.

FAMILY-OWNED AND OPERATED IN BANGALORE

Amrut was set up in 1948 and is still owned by the Jagdale family. They were the first Indian distillery to release single malt and they continue to make whisky that can rival Scotland.
