## JAPANESE WHISKY WITH CAPTIVATING FRESHNESS

A bright, complex and elegant blended malt whisky from Japan. This whisky is made from a combination of different casks from Nikka's Yoichi and Miyagikyo single malt distilleries and balances fruitiness from sherry cask aging with maritime flavours from Yoichi.

## CITRUS AND PEAT AROMAS WITH NOTES OF DARK CHOCOLATE AND RICH SMOKE

Made from a combination of Miyagikyo single malts which tend to have fruity, grassy and honeyed notes along with Yoichi single malts which lean towards nutty, smoky and salty flavours. Combined together, these whiskies give Taketsuru Pure Malt fruity citrus and pear notes along with darky chocolate and rich, maritime smoke.



## BEST ENJOYED NEAT OR IN A CLASSIC MANHATTAN COCKTAIL

Best enjoyed neat to fully appreciate the full complexity and layers of flavour from this tribute to the art of blending. This whisky is also perfect in a classic Manhattan cocktail.

## THE FATHER OF JAPANESE WHISKY

Nikka was founded in 1934 by Masataka Taketsuru, often referred to as "The Father of Japanese Whisky". Taketsuru travelled to Scotland in 1918 to learn the art of whisky-making.

## AN HOMAGE TO THE FATHER OF JAPANESE WHISKY

Masataka Taketsuru's adopted son, Takeshi, created this whisky in honour of his father to showcase the art of blending that Masataka valued so highly. The current release in the Taketsuru range contains a higher proportion of Yoichi than previous releases which adds a rich and earthy edge to the whisky and reflects Nikka's traditional flavour profile.
