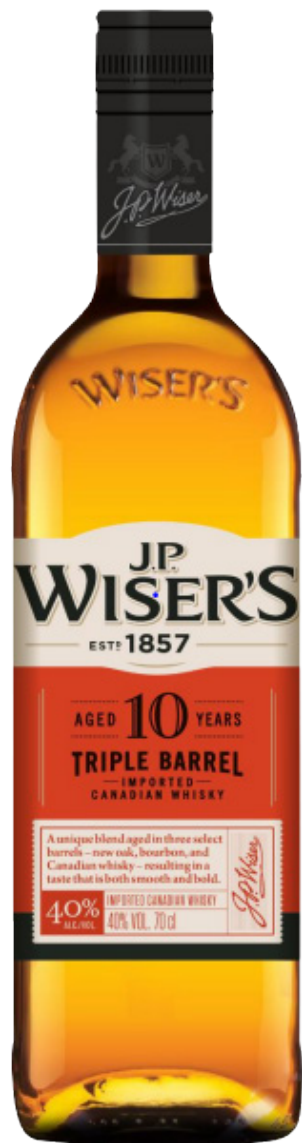

## AWARD-WINNING 10 YEAR OLD CANADIAN BLENDED WHISKY

An award-winning blended Canadian whisky made from a combination of corn and rye and aged for a minimum of 10 years in three cask types for extra complexity of flavour.

## NOTES OF GREEN APPLE, HONEYCOMB, RYE AND SPICE

The whisky has complex notes of vanilla, dried fruits, green apple, rye bread, toffee and allspice. The corn component (85%) gives it a creamy texture, while the rye component (15%) brings spice and nutty notes.

## COMPLEX FLAVOUR FROM AGEING IN THREE CASK TYPES

The whisky is matured in three different cask types: first-fill Ex-Bourbon casks bring dried fruit flavours, used Canadian whisky casks showcase the grain's character and virgin American oak casks add notes of vanilla and toffee.

## CANADA'S OLDEST CONTINUOUSLY PRODUCED WHISKY

In 1857, before Canada was Canada, J.P. Wiser was creating whisky in Prescott, Ontario. The whisky is still made using the traditional Canadian method of distilling each grain separately and blending the liquid after ageing.
